



All types of articles are welcome: perspectives, minireviews, research articles, commentaries, although the central idea is to share provocative thoughts in any of the formats.


Upon publication of these articles, a virtual joint thematic issue will bring together articles from both titles and will be promoted by FEMS and their publisher, Oxford University Press.
